**Steven M. Banzhaf:** Steve Banzhaf serves as Senior Vice President and Private Client Advisor for U.S. Trust Bank of America. He is also the Tucson Market President for Bank of America. Prior to joining Bank of America, he worked for a national securities brokerage firm for three years. Steve practiced law in Tucson for twenty-seven years before joining the brokerage firm. Steve served as Senior Vice President, General Council and Corporate Secretary for Tucson Electric Power Company. Steve is a Tocqueville Society member and past Chair of the Board of Directors of the United Way of Tucson and Southern Arizona. He is also a member of the Arizona Bar Association and serves as a Commercial & Employment Arbitrator for the American Arbitration Association. He served on the Board of Directors of the Mountain States Legal Foundation from 1985 – 1992. Steve holds a bachelor's degree from Brigham Young University and a law degree from the University of Arizona. He also completed the University of Michigan Executive Business Program in 1990.



**Michael and Lisa Hawkins:** Mike graduated from Albion College with an undergraduate degree in business. He began his career at Enterprise Rent-A-Car in 1989 as a Management Trainee in Detroit, MI. With a workforce of 12,500 employees and 2008 sales of \$5.4 billion, Raytheon Missile Systems is the world's leading producer of weapon systems for the United States military and the allied forces of more than 50 countries.

Prior to leading Raytheon Missile Systems, Dr. Lawrence served as Raytheon's vice president of Engineering, Technology and Mission Assurance. In that role he guided the company's vision and provided corporate leadership in the strategic areas of technology and research, engineering, operations, performance excellence, Raytheon Six Sigma and Mission Assurance, which include 45,000 world-class people working on more than 8,000 programs.

Dr. Lawrence holds a bachelor's degree in physics from the California Institute of Technology and a master's degree in applied physics from Stanford University. He earned his Ph.D. in applied physics from Stanford in 1992. Dr. Lawrence is vice chairman of the Air Force Studies Board of the National Academies and serves as an advisor to the Defense Science Board and Defense Policy Board. He is also a lifetime member of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics. In 1996, Dr. Lawrence was honored with the Secretary of Defense Medal for Meritorious Civilian Service.
