### **About EITC and VITA**

The EITC (Earned Income Tax Credit) Task Force is a partnership of United Way and more than 40 nonprofit organizations, with a mission of helping low- and moderate-income families receive EITC.

The EITC Task Force, in partnership with the IRS, offers free tax preparation every year to Tucson families and individuals at numerous sites throughout the Tucson area through the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program.

The VITA program allows families and individuals to receive every tax benefit available to them, including EITC. Families use the tax credit to cover basic needs, pay down debt or open a bank account, ultimately increasing their long-term financial stability.
